Accommodations for Costa Rica will be in two sections: Lodge Rooms above the Open Air Workspace (One Flight of Stairs; 4 Available, 2 Beds) and Family Bungalows (3 Available each consisting of 1 Single; 1 Double with 2 beds, Front Room with 2 Singles, 1 Bath) adjacent to the Jacuzzi, Spa, and Dining Hall (Ground Level, 3 Available, target of 3 artists per bungalow). All accommodations have a private bathroom with daily maid service. Although they are cabins and verge on rustic, they are actually very nice and quite comfortable. Both locations are extremely convenient to all activities.

Workshop (Cont)

- Our program will be suitable for painters, mosaic artists, and those who want to dabble a bit in both — novices welcome! In addition to lessons on design and color, Painters will explore the basics of working with gouache (a water based paint). Both Painters and Mosaicists will have the opportunity to work on abstracts as well as simple objects and scenes inspired by the jungle around us.
- **NOTE:** Due to baggage weight restrictions, students will be asked to bring some materials. Packing list, tips and suggestions will be provided.

- **All reservations require a 50% with the registration form. Reservations cannot be held without a deposit. Final balance is due November 1, 2020.**
- Deposits can be made by US check, PayPal, or Zelle.
- Payments by check or Zelle will incur no fees.
- If paying by PayPal, please use Friends and Family. Sending funds to Friends and Family incurs no fees for sender or receiver if you use your PayPal balance OR bank account. If you use PayPal **without** Friends and Family, there will be an additional fee charged to cover the fee taken by PayPal.

Cancellation and Refunds

Written cancellation is required to process a refund. For reservations cancelled by May 1, 80% is refundable. If cancelled after between May 2 - July 1, 50% is refundable. Between July 2 and November 1, 20% is refundable. After November 1, fee is non-refundable.

Although unlikely, the tour may be canceled due to unforeseen circumstances. Should any workshop/retreat be canceled, the entire amount paid will be refunded within fourteen days after the tour's cancellation. Instructors have no obligation regarding any additional costs or fees related to the issuance and/or cancellation of airline tickets or other travel reservations.

Group Leaders accept no liability for any airline cancellation penalty incurred by the purchase of a non-refundable ticket or for canceled flights. Travel Insurance is strongly recommended (see next section).
